"Hebraic Thinking": Mondays, March 16th and 23rd

Our Biblical ancestors used a qualitatively different kind of thinking process than we do, and it affects the way we read the Bible. Learn how the ancestors saw the past and the future. Learn how they experienced angels and ancestors, and the animate spirit in all creation.
