In March, Rabbi David's Jewish Spirituality Series continues with some very intriguing topics:

- ☆ **March 3rd at 7:30 p.m. – “Poetry of the Bible: A Look at the poetry of King David, Moses, Isaiah, Ezekiel.”** Metaphors were understood much more literally in Biblical times. We'll take a look at the animistic monotheism of our ancestors and see how their worldview can bring enlightenment and fulfillment to our own lives. Free.
- ☆ **March 10th at 7:30 p.m. – “Farginin - The Forgotten Yiddish Practice of Blessing.”** Learn the technique that can save families, synagogues, communities, and even businesses from tearing themselves apart from the inside. Farginin is a 500 year old practice of group empowerment. It follows simple rules that can be learned and applied quickly. Free.

“The Psalms of King David” – a six week class
