The class meets Thursday evenings, February 9 & 16, March 1, 15, 22 & April 5, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. for six sessions. A study group consisting of Christians and Jews tackling the difficult issue of anti-Semitism and the future of our shared vision of the messianic era. The course will answer questions like: what are the Jewish roots of the “Our father” prayer? What are the Jewish roots of the Eucharist? What did the notions of heaven, salvation, and redemption mean to religious Jews in the first century? What were the causes of Christian anti-Semitism?
